Our Operations

→ Livestock

Through mob grazing our livestock provides input to help enhance the soil and improve avocado tree health.

→ Orchard

Our orchard extends 600 acres with a total of about 90,000 trees planted.

→ Nursery

In our nursery, we graft and grow high-quality, disease-resistant seedlings that are sold to other growers or used to replace older trees within our own orchard.

→ Packing

We operate a packing facility that prepares avocados from our farm and local outgrowers for export to India and Dubai, ensuring premium quality and promoting Tanzanian produce abroad.



Orchard

We are in the process of implementing syntropic farming practices in our avocado orchard to promote soil health, biodiversity, and long-term productivity. By integrating companion plants, organic mulching, and natural succession principles, we enhance nutrient cycling, improve moisture retention, and reduce the need for external inputs. This regenerative approach creates a balanced ecosystem where avocados thrive alongside supportive species, leading to more resilient and sustainable production.

Nursery



- In our nursery, we cultivate high-quality seedlings through a careful grafting process to ensure strong, disease-resistant, and productive trees. The grafted seedlings are either sold to other growers or used within our own farm to replace older or less vigorous trees, helping maintain the overall health and productivity of our orchard.



Packing

We operate a packing facility that handles avocados from our own orchards as well as from local outgrowers in the surrounding area. Each fruit is carefully sorted, graded, and packed to meet international export standards, ensuring premium quality and freshness. Our packed avocados are then exported to markets in India and Dubai, supporting both our farm and local growers while promoting high-quality Tanzanian produce abroad.
